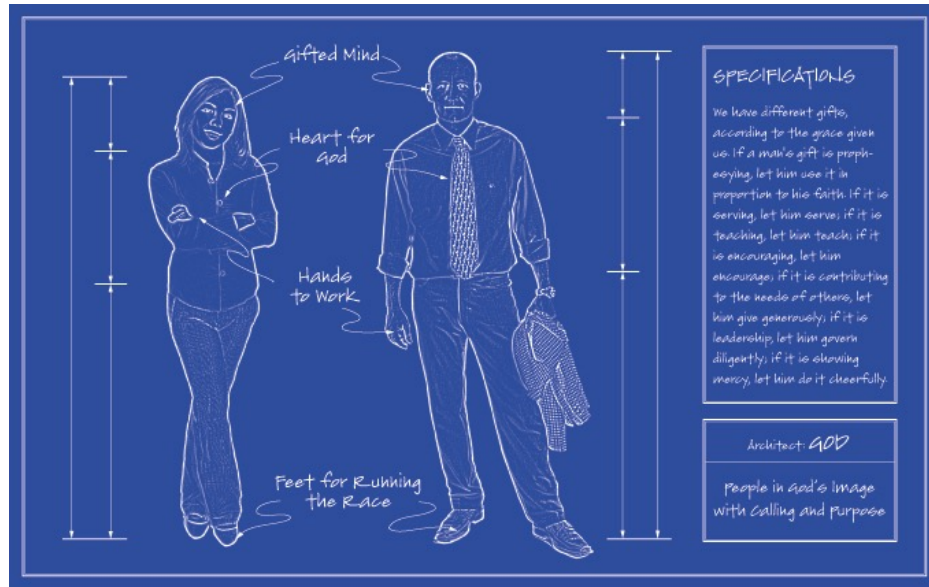

I. Your attitude toward your child's problem.

A. The impatient parent:

1. "Why me?"
2. "I have a right to a problem-free child."
3. "Child has no right to bother me."
4. Forgets that he needs to be trained.

I. Your attitude toward your child's problem.

B. The passive parent:

1. "It's no big deal, a passing phase."
2. "My kid would not do that."
3. "It's wong, but it's so cute."
4. "He's too young to learn."
5. "I don't know what I will do."

I. Your attitude toward your child's problem.

C. The biblical parent's attitude:

1. God uses trials (James 1:2-4).
2. Let Him complete & fulfill you.
3. Ask for wisdom (James 1:5).

II. Your charge from God.

A. To fathers: - Ephesians 6:1-4

1. Both Parents in 6:1-3
2. Mom still involved - Proverbs 6:1-3

II. Your charge from God.

B. Why single dad out?

1. Because dads tend to be neglectful of their responsibilities.
2. Because dads tend to be timid.
3. Because dad is accountable to God - 1 Timothy 3:4, 5
4. Doctrine of headship.

III. Parent's Goal: "Bring them up" - Eph. 6:4

A. Exegesis

1. Active voice: "YOU bring them up"
 - a. Not passive: "Be brought up"
 - b. Not middle: "Bring yourselves up" Consistent with Romans 5:12; Proverbs 22:6, 15
2. Present tense: indicates continuous action
3. Imperative mood: it's a command
4. Goal: positive, not negative - Not dependence, but Matthew 28:18-20; Colossians 1:28; Hebrews 5:14

III. Parent's Goal: "Bring them up" - Eph. 6:4

B. Can God bless your goal?

1. He has only one model! - Matthew 3:17; Romans 8:28-29a

2. Is He your model?

a. Isaiah 52:13: "Behold, my servant"

b. Luke 2:50-52: "He was in submission"

c. Luke 19:10: "He was a missionary" - Galatians 5:22-23

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
