ACT PREP WORKSHOP

The ACT Prep Workshop for students in grades 10-12 planning to take the ACT soon will be held at DCS on Tuesday, November 17th, 3:15 – 5:00 pm and Wednesday, November 18th, 3:15 – 5:00 pm. Students should attend both days and bring their calculators. Dan Morrison will instruct on ACT pacing/strategy, patterns of questions, and subject area content. Mr. Morrison has been providing ACT preparation services to students since he retired from Delaware City Schools in 2006 after thirty years as Hayes High School's Proficiency Test Intervention Coordinator. He has served over 1,500 students from Central Ohio high schools over the years through workshops and through private coaching. As of September 2015, 99.5% of his full program students have seen their ACT scores improve. The cost is \$40, and students can pay by check (written to Dan Morrison) or through school fees.
