When you then purchase these gift cards from us at the full face value price, the difference is kept by us as profit.

When you buy SCRIP, you may designate a student at Delaware Christian School to receive up to 50% of the profit from your purchase as tuition assistance. The remaining profit is directed into the church's building fund which also benefits the school.
