	<p>6th, 7th, 8th grade Supplies used <u>Across All Classes</u>: <i>These supplies need to be enough to use for all subjects.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Agenda/ Weekly Planner (Students need a calendar to keep track of assignments and due dates) *REQUIRED* Pencil pouch (no large pouches, bags, or mini backpacks) 3 packs college ruled Loose leaf paper Pencils (24- #2 pencils- no mechanical pencils) Erasers (2 pink erasers) 2 Green ink pens 3 different colored highlighters 1 pair of scissors medium or large size 3 Large glue sticks 1 large boxes of kleenexes (given to HR teacher) 1 containers of disinfecting wipes (given to HR teacher) Optional:Book Covers. Students have the option of covering their textbooks. It is their responsibility to turn in the textbook at the end of the year with no further damage or students will be charged for the price of the textbook (\$50-\$100). No contact paper or duct tape may be used in any form. Books can be covered at home or on the first day of school. Optional:Extra large 3 ring binder or trapper keeper to put each class colored folder and paper. This is only if the student wants all folders to be in one place or helps with organization. Optional: Small <u>one tier</u> locker shelf organizer.(Our lockers are half size lockers and students belongings fit better and neater with a one tier or no locker shelf. Also, locker decor should be minimal as it only adds to the disorganization of the locker. Students may not use tape on the lockers. Sticky tack or magnets may be used to hang decor or pics.)
